Along with our booth, there was a bouncy castle, a large parachute, a photo booth, and various games for the children to enjoy.

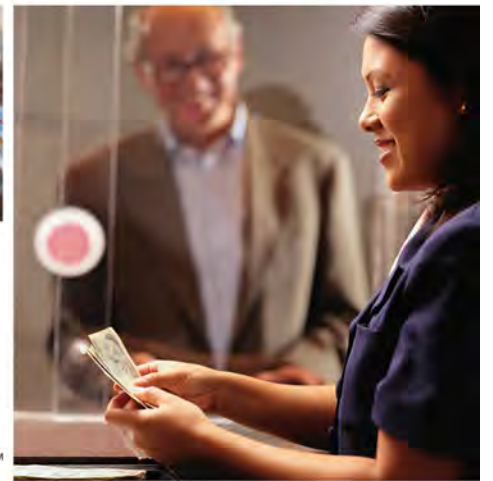

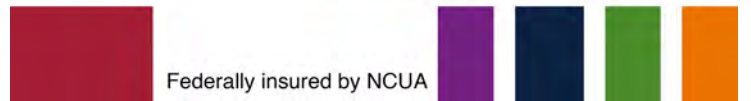
